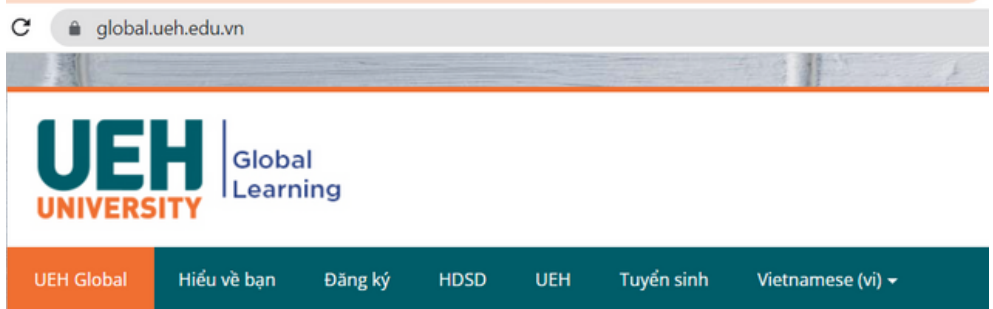

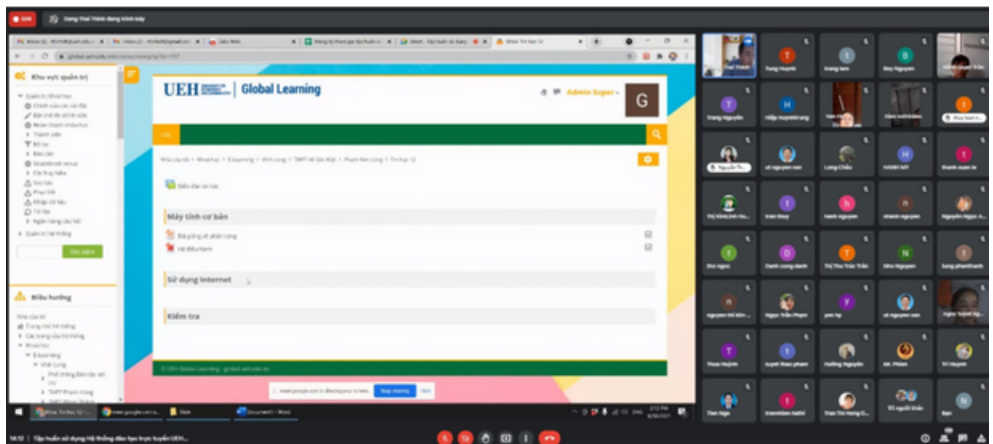
UEH GLOBAL LEARNING

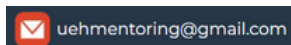
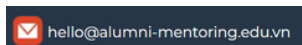
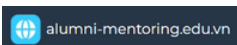
UEH Mentoring program

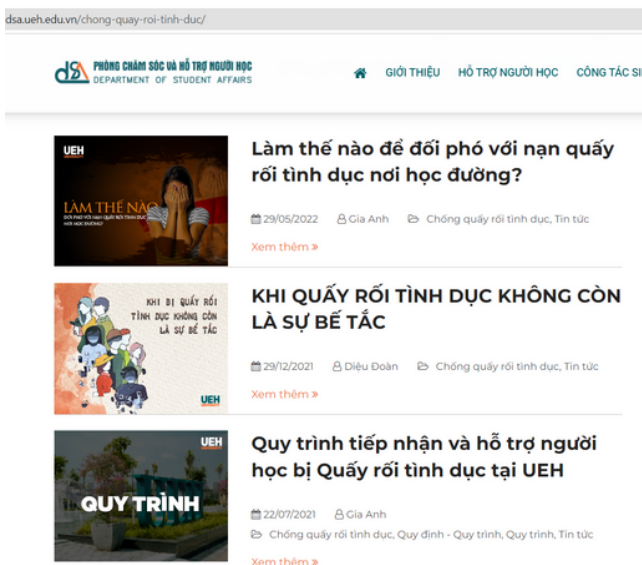

3.1. Điều kiện hưởng chế độ thai sản
 CCVC và người lao động được hưởng chế độ thai sản thuộc một trong các trường hợp sau:

- Nữ CCVC mang thai;
- Nữ CCVC sinh con;
- Nữ CCVC mang thai hộ và người mẹ nhờ mang thai hộ;

3.2. Thời gian hưởng chế độ thai sản
3.2.1. Nghỉ chế độ khám thai
 Trong thời gian mang thai, nữ CCVC và lao động nữ được nghỉ việc để đi khám thai 05 lần (mỗi lần một ngày). Trường hợp ở xa cơ sở y tế hoặc người mang thai có bệnh lý hoặc thai không bình thường thì được nghỉ 02 ngày cho mỗi lần khám thai.

Decent Work & Economic Growth

Promote sustained, inclusive and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment and decent work for all

We commit:

- Not to recruit anyone under 18 years old.
- The maximum working hour is 08 hours per day, 40 hours per week; overtime shall not exceed 50% of the normal working time. If employees work overtime, they will be paid
- Rest or leave periods with full salary and social insurance benefits
- Outsourcing employees are treated properly and with clear regulations via a contract signed by the University and outsourcing providers.
- Men and women are treated equally at the workplace in terms of employment, pay, bonuses, social insurance, labor conditions, and other working circumstances.
- The salary of lecturer and staff is regulated by fair policies according to a degree, work experience, position. There is no difference in treatment based on gender or sexual orientation
- UEH employees have the right to appeal acts and decisions affecting their rights and interests.
- UEH Union established in 1976 to ensure the legal rights of all employees

**CHƯƠNG I
QUY ĐỊNH CHUNG**

Điều 1. Mục tiêu của quy định

Nâng cao nhận thức, xây dựng ý thức sử dụng điện tiết kiệm và hiệu quả. Thay đổi thói quen sử dụng điện của cán bộ, viên chức theo định hướng tiết kiệm và hiệu quả điện năng tại cơ quan.

Điều 2. Phạm vi điều chỉnh

Tất cả các giảng viên, viên chức, viên chức trong toàn UEH.

**CHƯƠNG II
QUY ĐỊNH VỀ ĐẢM BẢO AN TOÀN, TIẾT KIỆM TRONG SỬ DỤNG ĐIỆN.**

Điều 3. Sử dụng tiết kiệm điện tại nơi làm việc.

Trường đơn vị chịu trách nhiệm quán triệt để toàn thể giảng viên, viên chức, người lao động nghiêm túc thực hiện quy định sử dụng tiết kiệm điện tại cơ quan. Trường đơn vị phải có trách nhiệm đề ra các quy định trong đơn vị về việc sử dụng tiết kiệm điện trong các phòng, các khu vực làm việc của đơn vị mình theo nguyên tắc:

- Các thiết bị dùng điện không cần thiết khi ra khỏi nơi làm việc và hết giờ làm việc phải được tắt. Khi hết giờ làm việc phải cắt triệt để nguồn điện trong phòng (ngoại trừ điện cung cấp cho server hoặc thiết bị quan trọng khác phải hoạt động liên tục 24 giờ/ngày).
- Tắt bớt đèn chiếu sáng, máy lạnh, quạt các loại trong giờ làm việc ở các khu vực không có hoặc có ít người làm việc. Khi sử dụng máy lạnh chỉ để chế độ làm lạnh không dưới 25 độ C. Không sử dụng quạt hút, không để mở cửa đi, cửa sổ của phòng khi đang sử dụng máy lạnh.
- Các loại máy vi tính, máy in, máy fax phải được cài đặt chế độ tiết kiệm điện năng, khi không sử dụng máy tự động ở chế độ chờ (standby).

Đối với các Khoa, Viện đào tạo, giảng dạy được bố trí làm việc tại các cơ sở, Trường đơn vị còn có trách nhiệm kiểm tra, quản lý các vấn đề liên quan đến sử dụng tiết kiệm điện trong cơ sở, kịp thời yêu cầu với nhân viên trực điện âm thanh, với bảo vệ ở cơ sở phải khắc phục sửa chữa ngay việc lãng phí và phản ánh thông qua Phòng Cơ sở vật chất các hiện tượng sử dụng điện lãng phí tại cơ sở như mở đèn hành lang cầu thang khi trời còn sáng, khi không cần thiết, các phòng học không có người học vẫn mở đèn quạt, máy chiếu...

Điều 4. Sử dụng tiết kiệm điện tại các phòng học, phòng họp.

Trách nhiệm của đơn vị, cá nhân sử dụng phòng học, phòng họp:

- Các đơn vị tổ chức chủ trì cuộc họp, giảng viên giảng dạy tại phòng học có trách nhiệm sử dụng tiết kiệm điện trong suốt thời gian sử dụng phòng học, phòng họp, hội trường.
- Khi sử dụng phòng học, phòng họp chỉ sử dụng các loại thiết bị, phương tiện (máy chiếu đa phương tiện, máy vi tính...) khi cần thiết. Không sử dụng máy chiếu, máy vi tính chỉ để chiếu mục lục bài giảng hoặc chiếu các nội dung không hỗ trợ thiết thực cho nội dung giảng dạy, học tập. Trong buổi học, buổi họp khi không cần sử dụng các loại thiết bị, phương tiện giảng dạy phải tắt máy hoặc cài đặt máy ở chế độ chờ (standby) nếu còn có nhu cầu sử dụng tiếp trong buổi học. Cuối giờ học, giờ họp phải tắt tất cả các thiết bị và đèn, quạt trong phòng.
- Các khoa/viện đào tạo, Văn phòng Đoàn Trường, Hội sinh viên Trường khi giới thiệu, khi xác nhận giấy xin mượn giảng đường, mượn thiết bị của các Đoàn Khoa, các Câu lạc bộ của sinh viên, cần xem xét mức độ cần thiết việc mượn thiết bị, phương tiện nghe nhìn. Các Khoa, Đoàn

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và Hội sinh viên Trường phải giáo dục nhắc nhở sinh viên tinh thần tiết kiệm cũng như phải chấp hành các quy định về sử dụng tiết kiệm điện trong học tập, sinh hoạt tại Trường.

Trách nhiệm của đơn vị quản lý sử dụng và phục vụ tại các phòng học, phòng họp, hội trường:

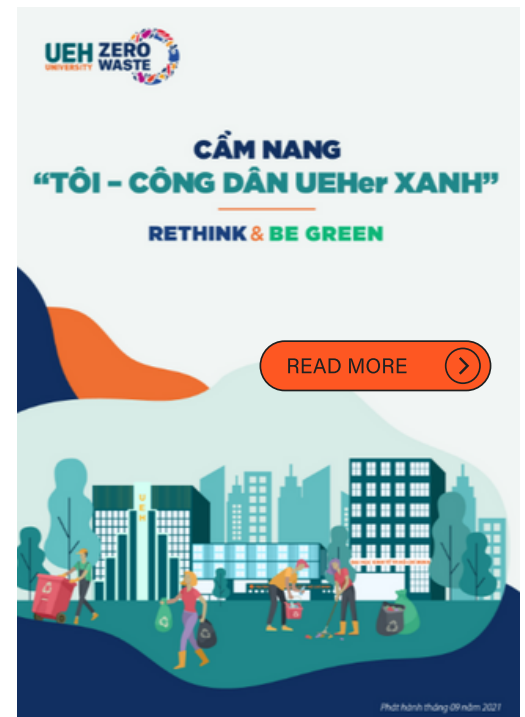
- Phòng Cơ sở vật chất là đơn vị quản lý sử dụng các phòng học, phòng họp, hội trường tại các cơ sở của Trường.
- Nhân viên phục vụ chỉ mở đèn, quạt, thiết bị trong các phòng học, phòng họp theo lịch của Trường (lịch của Phòng Kế hoạch đào tạo - Khảo thí và Văn phòng trường).

Điều 5. Sử dụng tiết kiệm điện tại các khu vực công cộng.

Khu vực công cộng trong quy định này bao gồm hành lang, cầu thang, sân vườn và các lối đi chung. Khu vực công cộng chủ yếu chỉ sử dụng điện vào việc thắp sáng. Để thực hiện tiết kiệm điện, chỉ khi cần thiết mới sử dụng đèn chiếu sáng cho các lối đi, cầu thang. Đèn hành lang trước các lớp học chỉ mở về đêm và khi khu vực hành lang đó không có phòng nào học. Các công tác đèn khu vực công cộng được lắp đặt ở vị trí thuận tiện và giao cho bộ phận bảo vệ tại mỗi cơ sở để có thể dễ dàng tắt mở đèn phục vụ công tác bảo vệ cơ sở lúc đêm khuya và tắt mở đèn chiếu sáng các khu vực khi cần thiết.

Appendix 15.1 (page 62) of UEH Internal Expense Regulation stipulates, in writing, the smart and effective consumption of electricity on campus, such as:

- Turn off all electric appliances when not in use or when leaving the office at the end of the day
- Devices should be left on standby, eco-mode and more

At the conference, researchers discussed the applied economics instrument and other emergent issues relating to adaptation, damages reduction induced by environmental consequences as well as the strategies of green growth, towards the region's comprehensively sustainable economic development such as policy-based tools, responsive scenarios, transition management, and international cooperation. Additionally, the conference was also conducted with 7 parallel sessions with topics of interest pertaining to Southeast Asia's Economy and Environment such as: Climate Change, Fisheries and Marine Resources, Environment and Development, Pollution and Health, Ecological Tourism and Services, Disasters and Adaptive Policy, and Environmental Valuation.



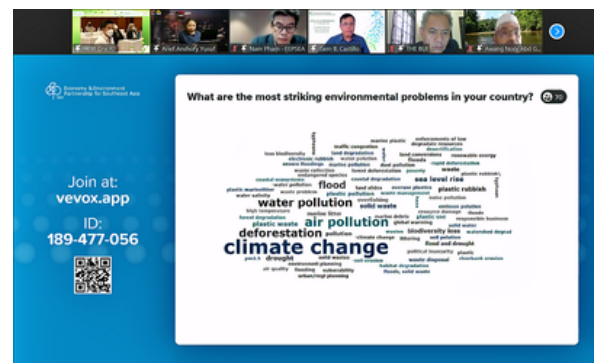
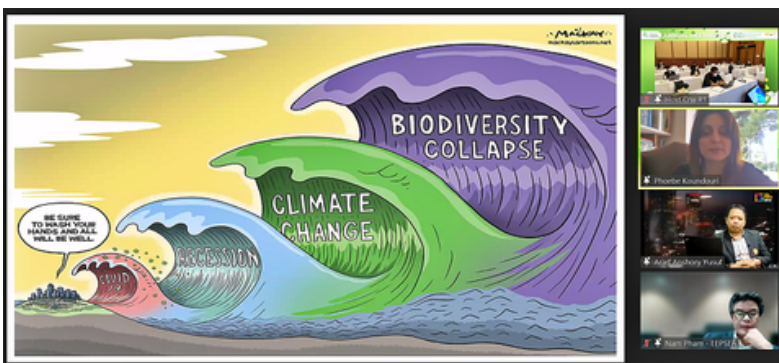
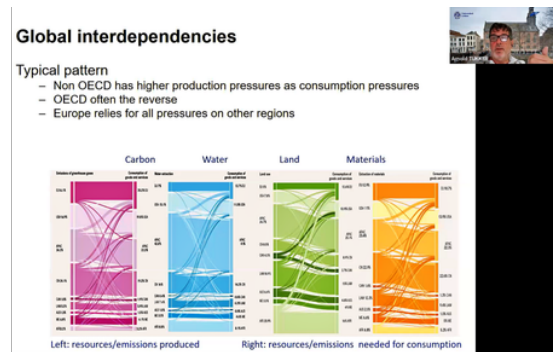
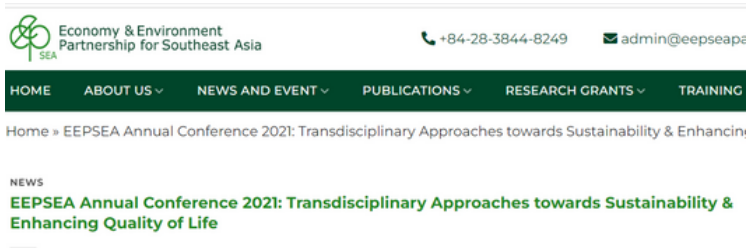

“Environmental Economics in Southeast Asia – Transdisciplinary Approaches towards Sustainability and Enhancing Quality of Life”

The conference “Environmental Economics in Southeast Asia – Transdisciplinary Approaches towards Sustainability and Enhancing Quality of Life” was hosted by the Economy & Environment Partnership for Southeast Asia (EEPSEA), jointly with the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (Sida), College of Economics, Law & Government at the UEH University, and Environment for Development Center in Vietnam. This is part of EEPSEA’s ongoing work in promoting research in environmental economics using transdisciplinary approaches to increase sustainability and enhance life quality

Following the introduction of EEPSEA’s grant programs, the conference continued with 3 parallel sessions: session 2A on Marine resource management, session 2B on Environmental valuation, and session 2C for new research proposals.

Waste separation (waste sorting) at source, currently, is an extremely important and urgent task that needs to be conducted in households, businesses, schools and so on in order to reduce the amount of waste going to urban areas, to process waste in a systematic manner with more responsibility and to avoid causing environmental pollution. One of the main goals of “UEH – Zero Waste Campus” Living Lab Project is to know how to properly classify waste at source and apply 3R model (Reduce – Reuse – Recycle) in sustainable waste management, bringing back the school and life environment greener and cleaner.
